‘JUST THE BRIDGE’ TAKE OVER AND MAKE OVER

The restaurant Just The Bridge has been bought by Christian Butler, formerly General Manager of Adam Street Private Members’ Club and Baltic Restaurants.

His new enterprise will be NORTHBANK, a restaurant and bar with a modern English menu.

Just the Bridge opened with such promise with the Millennium Bridge in 2001. However, while the ‘wobbly’ bridge managed to overcome its difficulties the restaurant never managed to meet expectations.

Christian has great plans to give this fantastic location the restaurant it deserves, “There are so many people living, working and visiting this very special spot along the river – 30,000 cross the Millennium Bridge every day- but no good local restaurant and bar. NORTHBANK will fill this gap”, he says.

MacKenzie Wheeler Architects (whose clients include The Quality Chop House, W’Sens, The Real Greek and Wagamama) will be creating a modern 90-cover restaurant and bar with an amazing terrace.

“NORTHBANK is all about the location. The view is classic London – the Tate Modern, Millennium Bridge and Southwark Bridge and the river itself- so while the interiors are important they will strongly reflect and heighten the exterior”, says architect Barney Bristow.

Work will finish at the end of the summer and NORTHBANK will open 15th October for lunch, dinner and private parties.
